Admission Requirements:

In addition to the general college admission requirements, students seeking entrance into the BSN-B program must have met the following criteria:

- Minimum GPA of 2.75 on a 4.0 scale
- Completion of all required prerequisite general education courses with a "C" (2.0) or above

The Registrar will evaluate the student transcript and complete a credit guide to formally approve the following specific courses that must be completed with a C or above. Science courses must be taken within the last 7 years prior to the date of enrollment in the program. One of the following courses may be taken in the first semester of the BSN-B program (with the exception of Anatomy and Physiology I & II or Microbiology) in order to be full-time.
