Overview

The Bachelor of Science in Health Sciences Degree is a two-year full-time program that can be completed on a part-time basis. The program includes online instruction and preceptored health science courses along with general education coursework. The program prepares allied health professionals to function as providers, managers, educators, and leaders in the health care environment.

Graduates function as collaborative members within the health care team. Knowledge of leadership and management, health provider systems, communication, critical thinking, legal-ethical principles, teaching-learning principles, evidence-based practice and accounting are integrated into the BSBS curriculum.

Graduates of the BSBS program are prepared to demonstrate the knowledge, proficiency, and cultural competence of an educated person, including the ability to synthesize general and professional education into clinical practice. The program reinforces accountability for lifelong learning and professional career development.

Admission Requirements

- Proof of state licensure or certification in a health sciences profession
- Graduation from a professionally accredited health sciences program
- Minimum GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale from an Associate Degree Program
