ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

This Articulation Agreement is between Eastern Iowa Community College District and Trinity College of Nursing and Health Sciences to facilitate the entry of qualified nursing students from the Associate Degree Program to the Baccalaureate Degree Program at Trinity College. This agreement promotes efficient transfer and eliminates barriers for graduates of Eastern Iowa Community College District entering Trinity College. In keeping with this agreement, the following issues are mutually agreed:

1. Trinity College of Nursing and Health Sciences will accept graduates of the Eastern Iowa Community College District Associate Degree in Nursing Program according to the Trinity College admission policies for the Bachelor of Science in Nursing Degree Program.

2. Trinity College of Nursing and Health Sciences will accept for its consideration, applications from those graduates of Eastern Iowa Community College and agree to place them in preferred seating in junior year nursing courses beginning in the subsequent summer session, fall, or spring semester. The application fee to Trinity College of Nursing and Health Sciences will be waived.

Applicants could be reviewed for conditional acceptance by Trinity College of Nursing and Health Sciences throughout their sophomore year at Eastern Iowa Community College District pending successful completion of their remaining courses and graduation.

4. Admission to the junior year at Trinity College of Nursing and Health Sciences is contingent upon the graduate having a Registered Nurse license. If individuals have not obtained their licenses, until such time the RN license is acquired, he or she may enroll in general education and non-clinical nursing courses.

5. Trinity College of Nursing and Health Sciences will use a transfer equivalency list to review and accept general education courses. In addition, any completed courses not listed on the Eastern Iowa Community College District required nursing curriculum plan or the equivalency list will be reviewed by the Registrar for potential transfer credit.

6. Trinity College of Nursing and Health Sciences and Eastern Iowa Community College District agree to notify the other agreement member of any major program/curriculum changes.

7. This agreement is valid for Eastern Iowa Community College District nursing graduates up to two years after their date of graduation.

EASTERN IOWA COMMUNITY COLLEGE Davenport, Iowa AGREEMENT OF COOPERATION WITH TRINITY COLLEGE OF NURSING & HEALTH SCIENCES Rock Island, Illinois

This agreement defines the procedures for a Joint Admissions Agreement between Eastern Iowa Community College District and Trinity College of Nursing and Health Sciences. This agreement focuses on Trinity students seeking to fulfill a portion of their requirements through attendance at one of the Eastern Iowa Community College District Colleges, i.e., Scott, Clinton, or Muscatine Community Colleges. This agreement will be effective for the period of May 1, 2005 through April 30, 2010. Prior to the expiration date, this agreement will be reviewed by both parties and appropriate changes incorporated. Intention of either party not to renew the agreement shall require notice to the other party at least six months prior to the expiration date. If terminated, students currently enrolled in the program will be allowed to complete the program and course of study.

Formal participation in this agreement will be the completion and submission of the EICCD Application for Admission, along with all the necessary application materials. AGREEMENT OF COOPERATION WITH TRINITY COLLEGE OF NURSING & HEALTH **SCIENCES**

Rock Island, Illinois

This agreement defines the procedures for a Joint Admissions Agreement between Eastern Iowa Community College District and Trinity College of Nursing & Health Sciences. This agreement focuses on Trinity students seeking to fulfill a portion of their requirements through attendance at one of the Eastern Iowa Community College District Colleges, i.e., Scott, Clinton, or Muscatine Community Colleges. This agreement will be effective for the period of March 1, 2011 through February 28, 2016. Prior to the expiration date, this agreement will be reviewed by both parties and appropriate changes incorporated. Intention of either party not to renew the agreement shall require notice to the other party at least six months prior to the expiration date. If terminated, students currently enrolled in the program will be allowed to complete the program

and course of study.

Formal participation in this agreement will be the completion and submission of the EICCD Thes later Application for Admission, along with all the necessary application materials. Official transcripts of all past education translated into English. Must provide evidence of proficiency in the English language (in the form of Test of English as a Foreign Language, TOEFL; EICCD schools require a score of 500 or better on the paper test, 173 on the CBT, 61 on the IBT). Trinity College of Nursing & Health Sciences requires a score of 550 or better on the written test, 213 on the CBT 79-80 on the IBT with a score of at least 23 on the speaking portion of the exam. Proof of financial responsibility will be maintained at Trinity College of Nursing & Health Sciences.

Upon receipt of the Joint Application for Admission and all necessary EICCD application -materials, the student will be officially accepted into the Joint Admission Program with Eastern Iowa Community College District and Trinity College of Nursing & Health Sciences. Each student participating in this agreement will be afforded all benefits as outlined in this document.

PROGRAM GUIDELINES

The Joint Admission Program is designed to provide participating students with additional options to meet course requirements established by Trinity College of Nursing & Health Sciences.

For purposes of this agreement, Trinity College will be considered the "home" institution and is responsible for monitoring student eligibility requirements, record keeping and distribution of student financial aid. As such, Trinity College will be notified whenever it would appear that a joint admissions student is experiencing difficulties that would hinder their success in the program.

INSTITUTIONAL COMMITMENTS

Trinity College agrees to provide the following as its part of the partnership for the Joint Admission Program with Eastern Iowa Community College District:

- 1. Pay the designated tuition rate for students participating in the Joint Admissions Program.
- 2. Cooperate in the concurrent and terminal evaluation of students in the courses.

- 3. Provide classroom space for courses taught at Trinity College of Nursing & Health Sciences.
- 4. Ensure that all enrolled students are advised on meeting the requirements of the program for Trinity College of Nursing & Health Sciences.

Eastern Iowa Community College agrees to:

Course Number

- 1. Provide the following coursework necessary for completion of the Joint Admissions Program.
- 2. Provide all coursework to Trinity College students at a tuition rate equivalent to the current year's in-state tuition and student fees.
- 3. Provide support services as received by Eastern Iowa Community College District students.
- 4. Provide course syllabus for each of the courses in the attached listing as requested.
- 5. Provide curriculum vitae of all involved faculty upon request.
- 6. Have chairpersons and faculty at Eastern Iowa Community District College, upon request assist Trinity College Registrar and faculty in determination of acceptance for transfer credit for specific equivalent general education courses from institutions other than Eastern Iowa Community College District.
