Trinity College of Nursing & Health Sciences Higher Education Emergency Relief Funds III (HEERF III) Grant

Trinity College of Nursing & Health Sciences was awarded a Higher Education Emergency Relief Funds (HEERF) grant. On April 15, 2020, Trinity College signed and returned the certification and agreement required to receive the student portion (or 50%) of the HEERF grant. On April 1, 2021, Trinity College of Nursing & Health Sciences received \$233,812 in HEERF III grant funds.

As of May 24, 2021, Trinity College had 138 nursing students who were enrolled in the summer 2021 semester and therefore eligible to receive the HEERF III grant. 74 students who had EFCs between 0 and 5846 received checks for \$550 and 64 students with EFCs higher than 5846 received \$300. On June 9, 2021 the 138 students were notified of their individual awards via email from the Director of Business Services. Trinity College of Nursing & Health Sciences awarded \$59,900 from this grant fund directly to students.

All radiography students who were enrolled in classes during the summer 2021 semester were deemed eligible for and were awarded grant funds. 8 students who had EFCs between 0 and 5846 received checks for \$550 and 5 students with EFCs higher than 5846 received \$300. On July 14, 2021 the 14 students were notified of their individual awards via email from the Director of Business Services. Trinity College of Nursing & Health Sciences awarded an additional\$5,900 from this grant fund directly to students.

All students who were enrolled in classes during the fall 2021 semester were deemed eligible for and were awarded grant funds. 72 students who had EFCs between 0 and 5846 received checks for \$750 and 66 students with EFCs higher than 5846 received \$450. On September 14,2021 the 138 students were notified of their individual awards via email from the Director of Business Services. Trinity College of Nursing & Health Sciences awarded an additional \$83,700 from this grant fund directly to students.

All students who were enrolled in classes during the spring 2022 semester were deemed eligible for and were awarded grant funds. 68 students who had EFCs between 0 and 5846 received checks for \$700 and 63 students with EFCs higher than 5846 received \$582.73. On February 4, 2022 the 131 students were notified of their individual awards via email from the Business Services Specialist. Trinity College of Nursing & Health Sciences awarded the final \$84,312 from this grant fund directly to students
