ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum Degree GPA of 2.75 on a 4.0 scale
- Licensed Practical Nurses (LPN) who hold a current unencumbered license are eligible to receive advanced standing credit for NUR 330 (3 credits) and NUR 332 (5 credits) upon successful completion of the NLN Nursing Acceleration Challenge Examination: Foundations of Nursing Exam, prior to the first semester of the curriculum.
