TRANSFERABLE COURSES

Trinity College maintains cooperative agreements with Black Hawk College, Eastern Iowa Community Colleges, and Portage Learning. Academic credit will generally be accepted from other regionally accredited institutions upon review. Admission representatives will unofficially review transfer credit for applicants during the pre-application process. Upon receipt of the application, the Registrar will evaluate the student transcript to formally approve transfer credit.

Students will have 75 credits of Advanced Standing from their associate's degree applied towards the completion of the BSHS degree.
