TRANSFERABLE COURSES

Trinity College maintains cooperative agreements with Black Hawk College, Eastern Iowa Community Colleges, and Portage Learning. Academic credit will generally be accepted from other regionally accredited institutions upon review. Admission representatives will unofficially review transfer credit for applicants during the pre-application process. Upon receipt of the application, the Registrar will evaluate the student's transcript to formally approve transfer credit. Other recommended courses include genetics, molecular biology, organic chemistry, analytical chemistry, and cell biology. After conditional acceptance into the MLS program, official acceptance is contingent upon successful completion of all outstanding prerequisite general education courses and the maintenance of a GPA at or above 2.8. Prospective students may contact the program director before and after applying for any prerequisite inquiries.
